SANCHAR is a voluntary organization under the Societies oif Registration Act, XXI of 1860 established since the year 1995. Its presence spreads over to Odisha, Chhatisgarh and Jharkhand states.

The organization has mainly contributed its services for the welfare of the vulnerable groups. Providing shelter and taking care of food and health care of the Sr. citizens, rescuing and rehabilitating the exploited and trafficking women, empowering the vulnerable women through need based capacity building trainings, providing shelter, food and health care to the transgenders and beggars and enhancing their skill capabilities for sustainable earnings, motivating the local artisans and giving them trainings for production of value added products out of the available resources, providing education facilities to the disabled children and working for the control of substance uses.

Besides, a number of trainings, seminars, publicity propaganda and meetings are organized from time to time to aware the common people about protection and control Covid-19 pandemic situation, consumers behaviour, road safety, environment protection, etc.

Grants-in-aids from Govt. of India, CSR contributions from different corporate sectors, collection from volunteers and donations from public are the main sources of funding. The last year annual turnover has reached nearly Rs. 1 crore.

The selfless services of the volunteers during Covid-19 pandemic situations is quite praised worthy.

Running Three Citizen Homes

AT JHINKIPANI, JHARKHAND

A 50 bedded Senior Citizen Home has been running at Basahatu near Jhinkipani Railway Colony since April 2020. with financial support from Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. All the inmates are provided with shelter, free food, clothing and health care facilities in the Senior Citizen Home. The inmates are also engaged in Kitchen gardening and regular YOGA practices is going on. Required staff members are engaged to take care of the inmates. Chaibasa is the district Headquarters of West Singhbhum district and it is only 16 kms far away from Jhinkipani.



AT SAREIKELA, JHARKHAND

Last year SANCHAR has set up one Senior Citizen Home at Sareikela Kharsuan district Head Quarters where 25 aged persons are staying. The Senior Citizen Home is managed from organizational funds. M/s. Rungta Mines is also providing different food materials from time to time. The inmates are provided with free food, uniforms and health care facilities. The organization has proposed submit proposal before the ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India.



AT RAIGARH, CHHATISGARH

One 50 bedded Senior Citizen Home has already established at Dongadhakel near Kirodimal Nagar of Raigarh district since January 2020. The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India has approved the project and necessary financial support is provided. The inmates staying in the Senior Citizen Home are provided morning tiffin, lunch, snacks and dinner on free of cost. The appointed doctor use to visit the center twice in a week and the inmates are given scope for outing and visiting different tourist spots. Required man powers are engaged to look after them.



Rescuing & Rehabilitating Exploited and Trafficking Women



Mostly tribal women of both Jharkhand & Chhatisgarh states are exploited and trafficked to other states and they are either sexually abused or tortured. Even many are the victims of violence. SANCHAR volunteers are regularly working to find out such incidents and rescuing them. The exploited women are counselled and wherever possible necessary assistance is given to rehabilitate them through self-employment. SANCHAR has already set up one shelter home at Sareikela Kharsuan district in Jharkhand state and other shelter home at Raigarh district of Chhatisgarh state since the year 2020. The beneficiaries are provided necessary legal justice and arranging sources of their earning.



Fighting for the rights of Beggars and Transgenders

Services for the Transgenders:

Transgenders are mostly neglected group of the society. Neither they are given their proper identity and recognition. Finding no other alternatives, they are moving here & there for their survival. SANCHAR has already set up a shelter home for their stay and utilizing them generate income sources through tailoring works since the year 2020. Already 17 such transgenders are given shelter and provided free food in the Shelter home at Sareikela Kharsuan district of Jharkhand state.

Services for the Beggars:

SANCHAR has set up two shelter homes for beggars since the year 2020. One is functioning at Jhinkipani of Jharkhand state and the other one is existing at Dongadhakel in Raigarh district of Chhatisgarh state. At Jhinkipani shelter home there are 26 beggars who are provided with free food and health care facilities through nearby Government hospitals. Similarly at Dongadhakel shelter home there are 23 beggars. The inmates are provided with free food and health care facilities. Efforts are being made to provide them necessary skill development training of carpentry and spice making as their sources of income.





Running Residential Special Schools in Jharkhand State





SANCHAR has established two Residential Special Schools at Jhinkipani of West Singhbhum district and in Gumla District HQs of Jharkhand State. About 30 VI,HI, MR children have taken admission in each of the school where they are provided with free education and residential facilities. Professional teachers have been deployed for giving them proper education. A few non-technical staff have also been engaged to take care of the disabled children.

The children reading in the Special School are also given facilities for involvement in various recreational activities, like songs, art, dance and sports. The nearby doctor is also requested to visit the school for their regular health check-up and wherever necessary medicines are provided.

The organization has not yet received any financial support either from state and central government. Only a few corporate sectors and well wishers are donating for continuance of the school. This year the organization has planned to submit proposals before the state government and the Govt. of India for providing financial assistance.



Organizing Skill Development Programmes

There are many tribal girls and women in Jharkhand state who are economically very poor. Some of them are also educated. Still they are unemployed. Only they need to be imparted skill training in different sectors for employment opportunity and preferring self employment. However, SANCHAR has made initial effort to identify 25 girls/women of tribal community and necessary arrangements have been made to give them tailoring training. In this regard Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has been consulted and accordingly proposal shall be submitted to provide trainings on Tailoring, Beautician, Physiotherapy & Spa, Food processing, DTP & Data Processing, etc.

Besides, there is ample scope in Jharkhand to promote tribal handicrafts. SANCHAR volunteers working sincerely to revive handicraft cluster in West Singhbhum. Accordingly the artisans are consulted and mobilized to start their handicraft works in modern and scientific process with the help of machineries.





Controlling Drug Abuses and Treatment of Addicts in Jharkhand & Chhatisgarh

It is now a concern in almost all the social community that very young school and college going guys are in habit of consuming different type of drugs and alcohol. It is also quite surprising that young girls are also fallen prey of this habit. Of course unsystematic life style, parental attitude, excessive stress and strain are the main causes of this bad habit. Consuming drugs and alcohol is also paving the way towards burglary, theft, and unethical work practices. During last two years the organization has set up De-addiction Centers at Jhinkipani of West Singhbhum district and Gumla District HQs in Jharkhand state to control drug uses and treatment of addicts. Regular awareness programme, work-shops & seminars are being conducted to aware the common people and youth society regarding the worst effects of using drugs and alcohols. Similarly, the organization has been running one Drug De-addiction center at Dongadhakel in Raigarh district for controlling drug abuses and consumption of alcohol. Where our volunteers find most addicted persons they are giving proper counselling and taking them to our part-time doctor for necessary treatment. In the process, our volunteers have cured 15 such addict persons.







Work-shops/ Seminar & Awareness Programmes

Work-shop on Environment Pollution

Most of the people are not aware about the duties & responsibilities of consumers. A seminar was organized on 20th Oct. 2021 at Fakirpur village where about 100 participants were present, They were explained about role and responsibilities of consumers and the remedial measures to fight against the shop owners.

One work-shop and one seminar on Environment Pollution have been conducted at Anandapur & Ghasipura towns. The participant have been explained about the role of each individual person towards control of environment pollution and importance was given for plantation of more number of trees to get rid of environment pollution,
